Use to get a good visual representation of the range of your students' scores.

1) Choose an assessment for which you have scores for each student
2) Divide the range of test scores into blocks

Examples: If test scores are a percentage, blocks might be: 0-25\%, 26-60\%, 61-70\%, 71-80\%, 81-90\%, 91-100\%

- If using a test with RIT scores, use ranges of 10 RIT points: 191-200, 201-201, 211-220, etc.

3) Write students' names in the boxes based on their scores
4) Use for flexible grouping and differentiation planning
